



Krowne's **Caster Positioning Chock** is a caster placement system designed to create a home position for all movable kitchen equipment. Caster chocks allow for equipment to be returned to its appropriate location, in relation to fire suppression and ventilation systems, after the removal for cleaning and maintenance purposes.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Attributes:

- Can be used with all caster-mounted equipment
- Satisfies the requirements of NFPA Codes 17A (5.6.4) and 96 (12.1.2.3)
- Made of heavy duty, stainless steel construction
- Easy Installation
- Hardware included

Parts & Hardware Included:

- (2) Stainless Steel Caster Positioning Chocks
- (8) Hex Screws
- (8) Drop In Anchors



STEP 1

Mark hole locations at desired location for the caster positioning chock.



STEP 2

Using a 3/8" bit, drill 3/4" through each point. Place an anchor in each hole. Ensure they are flush.



STEP 3

(Optional) If desired, apply silicone sealant around the bottom exterior of the caster positioning chock.



STEP 4

Position each caster positioning chock into their final location and secure with screws.



Note that the chock is positioned so the kitchen appliance is stationed under the hood.



STEP 5

Move appliance into position.
