
Assembly Instructions Small Cedar Corner Display Stand 48W x 31 1/2H x 24D (Item 345)

<u>Contents:</u> 2 - Leg Assemblies 3 - Shelves 4 - 2 1/2" Screws 13 - 1 1/2" Screws <u>Tools Needed:</u> Medium Phillips Screwdriver



1.) Stand leg assemblies on floor and line up at a 90 degree angle so that the two arm extensions on 2" x 2" leg over lap the 2" x 4" leg. Insert two 2 1/2" screws through pre-drilled holes in 2" x 4" leg. Insert 2 - 1 1/2" screws through pre-drilled holes in 2 x 4". Insert 2 - 2 1/2" screws through pre-drilled holes in bottom arm and attach to 2" x 4".

2.) Place large shelf on bottom arms, push back until it touches 2" x 4" leg. Line up four pre-drilled holes in center of arms, insert 1 1/2 screws and attach.

3.) Repeat step 2 for middle shelf.

4.) Top shelf - small triangle

Center and line up middle slat and back slat with marks on top of leg. Insert three 1 1/2" screws through predrilled holes and attach.


5.) A cleat $1 \ge 2 \ge 10^{\circ}$ long with two pre-drilled holes has been provided to tie two or more plant stands together for extra strength. Place the cleat under the rear of the top shelf against the leg. Make sure ends are flush with the $2 \ge 4$ upright & attach with screws.

If more than one corner plant stand is to be used together in a display, it is critically important the shelves are straight up and down on the outside edge (flush). There are two simple ways to do this.

A.) Complete step 1 on the assembly instruction sheet. Place one leg assembly in a corner so that the ends of the shelves are flush against the walls BEFORE you screw the shelves down. Repeat the process with each unit.

B.) BEFORE SHELVES ARE ADDED, place all the leg assemblies together as you plan to use them. Add the shelves. Make sure screw holes line up and ends of shelves touch then screw down shelves.

If individual units are totally assembled before organizing the display—the ends will not necessarily match up because of variation in placement of the shelves on the legs.



Two stands side by side will make an attractive display against a flat wall.
